FROM MOON TO MARS STARSHIP

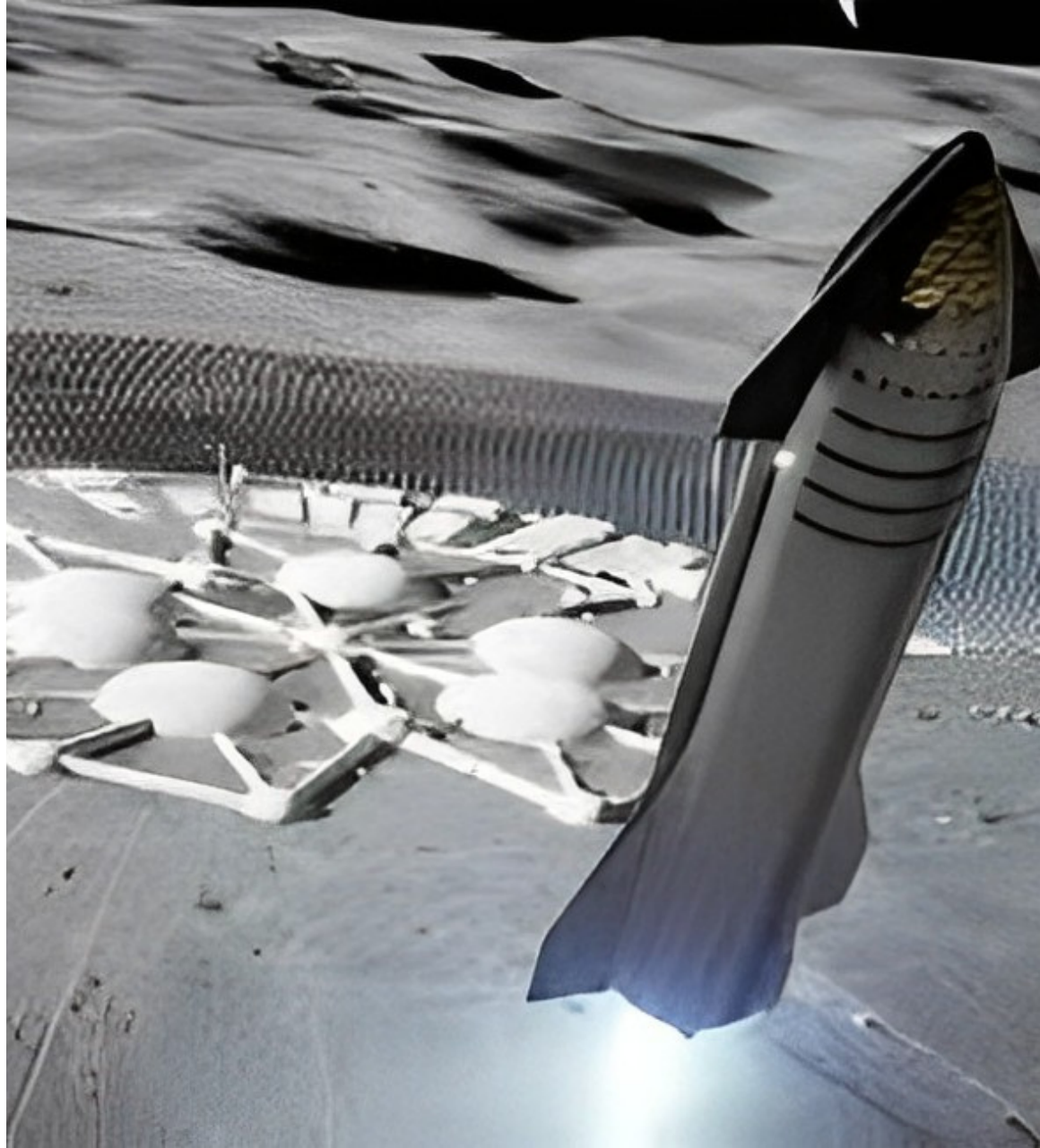
Thanks to its aerodynamic shape and totally reusable transportation system, Musk's newest Starship was developed to reduce the waste and transportation expenses associated with space travel, resulting in a more sustainable form of aerospace exploration and space tourism.

Simply referred to as Starship, the SpaceX Starship spaceship and Super Heavy rocket are a fully reusable for transportation system intended to take passengers as well as cargo to the mars, and moon. Although the super-heavy-lift launch vehicle is the tallest and most powerful launch vehicle ever made, it's essential to highlight that this achievement in aerospace

engineering is also creating the way for a future of space exploration that is less destructive to the environment and sustainable.

Raptor engines power the two-stage to orbit launch vehicle, which reaches a height of 400 feet and uses liquid oxygen and liquid methane as fuel. This method enables both an increase in launch frequency and a much lower launch cost.

On Thursday, April 20, 2023, early in the morning, the SpaceX Starship prototype launched.



The launch was stunning, and the SpaceX anchors on the webcast seemed jubilant over the volume of "data" collected. Before returning to Earth's atmosphere and conducting a precise splashdown in the Pacific Ocean not far from Hawaii, the Starship spaceship had travel approximately one circle around the earth. 8 minutes after takeoff, the Super Heavy booster was supposed to make a controlled landing in the Gulf of Mexico about 20 miles (30 km) off the Texas coast.

WE ARE ALL WONDERFUL



A commendable gesture was witnessed by a father, who remarried his own wife so that his daughters could inherit his property. An Advocate from Kerala, Mr. C Shukkur, took this initiative and married his wife for a second time under the Special Marriage Act, 1954.

The parents of two girls, were married for almost three decades when they decided to take this novel step. What was their motivation? The law of inheritance which is followed by

Mohammedans in India is discriminatory towards their daughters and the property of the father would've devolved to Mr. Shukkur's brother (uncle of the girls). This was the reason that they married under the Special Marriage Act, 1954 so that the property could be governed and be inherited by the daughters under the Indian Succession Act, 1925.



The Holy Quran presents elaborate rules of inheritance and that's been the reason for much of the misunderstanding surrounding the share of inheritance by women. One of the main verses in the Quran with regard to inheritance (4:11-12) allocates the shares to men and women on the basis of the position or role in society at the time of Prophet Mohammad. Rule 4:11 for example, provides that son will get double the share of a

daughter. The reason for the allotment of higher shares to the men, it has come to be known is because of the distributive justice and diffusion of the economic gains, with regard to the responsibilities.

Coming back to the year 2023, Mr. C Shukkar has set a brave example for many fathers. It could also be seen as a need for reform in the laws governing inheritance. Women today are more than capable of taking

care of their parents and therefore a change in the perspective of parents and the law-makers is necessary, so as to empower them to inherit the property to which they have all the inherent rights. The position in the Hindu succession law was not much different until 2005. But change needs to come from within the societies and the "progressive" parents of today must decide which direction they want to take.

BEHIND THE LOGO



Unilever didn't have a logo until 1967. The designer was of the view to sketch a design that symbolises their variations and customer relation by a single symbol.



They employed an allegoric symbol that represented the harmony between the two vertical lines of the letter "U." They represented the manufacturer's solidity and seriousness. Moreover, the grey colour was changed to blue. The "U" was double and pointed in the upward direction. They had a unique form that made them mimic fountain pens' fountain heads. But it was compared with the World Trade Centre complex's twin towers mostly.

A brand that controls 90% of our household- Hindustan Unilever- perfectly illustrates how different items may be successfully combined in one spot. And there is a lot behind the giant 'U' logo of Unilever.

On the occasion of the international corporation's 75th anniversary in 2004, the design was altered once since then. The current logo, in

in contrast to the old one, was present on every Unilever product.

Many people don't know the symbol within the letter U have a distinct meaning and each of the 25 symbols means a variety of things. For instance, a palm tree may represent paradise or oil, a bee may represent sweets or agricultural items, and a bird may represent the entire globe or Dove goods. The icons are also grouped according to their meanings.

Beauty is connected with flowers, plants, lips, and hair; purity is related to water, sunshine, and bubbles; food is associated with fish, hot peppers, and ice cream; and nature is associated with trees, birds, fish, and insects.

Each component represents a certain facet of the organisation. A heart (a symbol of love), two arrows (a recycling symbol), DNA (which is meant to be taken literally as the brand's DNA), and many more symbols are among them.

The corporation has used blue as its main colour since 1990. It changed colour in 2004, making the emblem more distinct. The selected colour is quite similar to #06069B.

ONLINE GAMING BANNED?

The government tried to regulate online gaming by classifying them into the game of skill & game of chance.

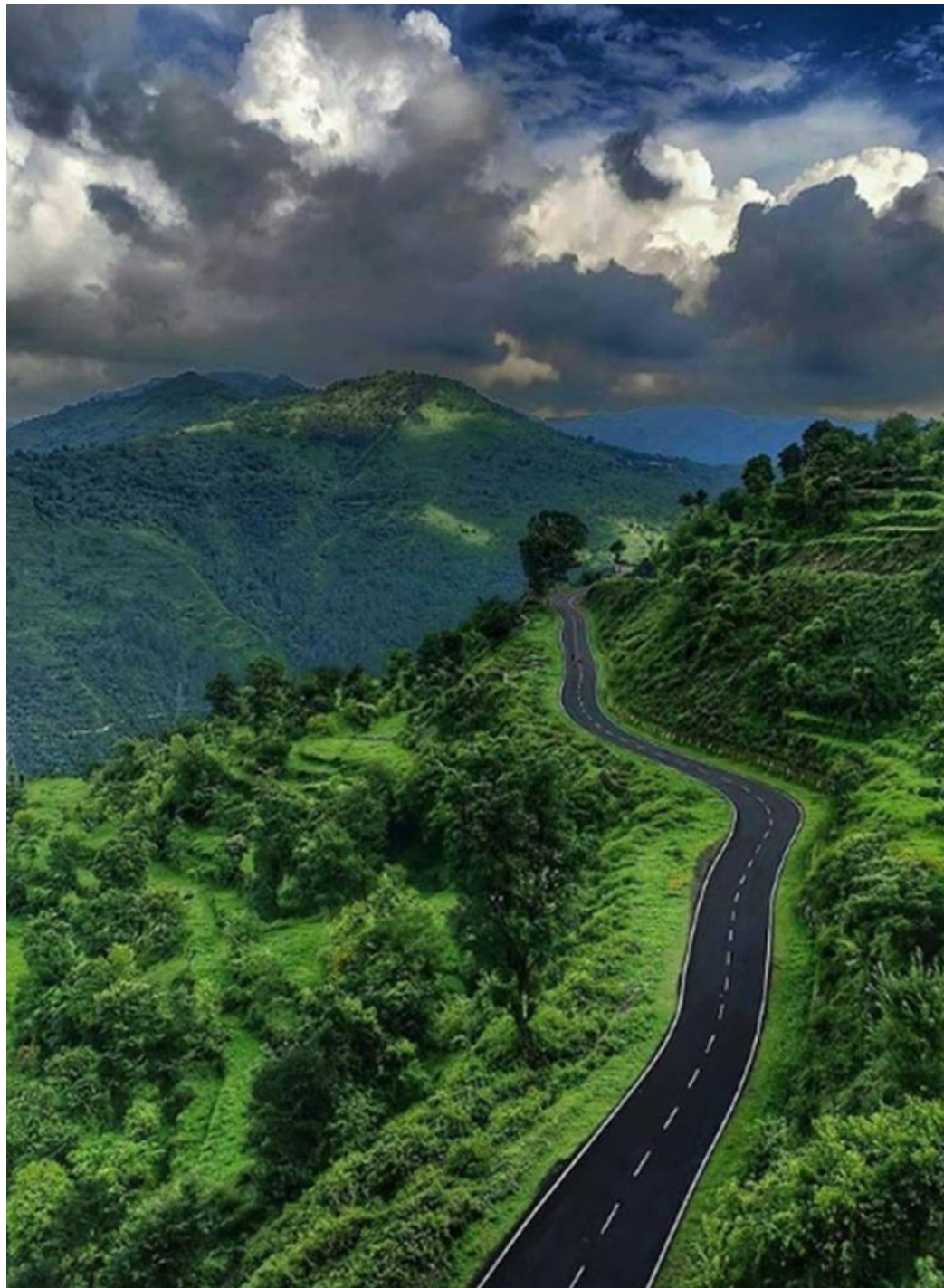

dependent on luck which player will perform the day and your chance of winning depend on luck but choosing the player for the team ultimately requires skill. Moreover, the law regulating gambling differs in different states as it is legal in the case of Goa but banned in Telangana.

At last, the complete banning of online gaming is not the permanent solution, instead, some regulations are required such as a limit can be imposed on how much money one put into online gaming per day, App usage timing restriction can be imposed and parental control in case of minor gamer is necessary.

LANSDOWNE

A well-kept secret in Uttarakhand, Lansdowne is so peaceful that one only learns of its existence after passing through the opulent Garhwal Rifles Cantonment.



The British discovered the town and got its name from the then Viceroy of India, Lord Lansdowne.
